

Camp Staff Opportunities

Director	1	Oversee camp function and campers. Facilitate auxiliary staff and Big Brother/Sister meetings. Help with shower time. Disciplinarian for kids with issues.
Manager	1	Connect with big camp manager for camp needs. Facilitate crafts. Oversee janitor. Inventory supplies.
Bible Teacher	1	Facilitate memory work, classes, Big Brother/Sister devotions, and story time. Counsel Big Brothers and Sisters.
Nurse (MO cert req'd)	1	Connect with the big camp nurse and in the case of a big camp emergency cover for him or her.
Cook	1	Experience with quantity cooking. Responsible for all meal related details except menu planning and purchasing. This includes food and dining hall preparation and clean-up, as well as tending to dishes.
Dining Room Assistant	1	Assist the cook. (i.e. food prep, dining hall, dishes, decorations, etc.)
Janitor	1	Maintain clean "public" areas on the campground. Do laundry.
Big Brother/Sister	10	This is about relationships. Stay with the kids. (meals, classes, memory work, swimming, free play, tea time, etc.) Help with chores as assigned (nap time, overnight, showers, swim time, etc.) Complete paperwork on each child.

Big Camp

A full big camp is comprised of the 152 people (56 staff people and 96 campers) and can be housed as follows:

96 campers and 24 cabin staff equals 120 people being housed in cabins.

Administrative Staff (5) ➤ Responsible to the Director ➤ oversee several staff people ➤ make team decisions for camp as a whole.	Director	1	Oversee administrative team, camp function, and campers, as well as facilitating cabin staff meetings. Disciplinarian for kids with issues.
	Assistant Director	1	Assist the director. . . especially with camp function and child discipline.
	Staff Director	1	Oversee the cabin staff. Help them maintain balance throughout the week. Provide daily devotion?
	Recreation Director	1	Oversee the activity staff. (daily devotion, team meeting, etc.)
	Manager	1	Oversee the auxiliary staff. (daily devotion, team meeting, etc.) Take care of interaction with the "outside world" for all camp participants. (i.e. purchases) Communicate with CUM staff in KC.
Cabin Staff (24) ➤ Responsible to the Staff Director ➤ fend for needs and growth of "their" campers	Counselors (6 male/6 female)	12	Help "their" campers to be prepared and punctual for each activity. Set a good example and counsel the campers in healthy relating, self-image, spiritual growth, personal hygiene, etc. Maintain discipline among campers.
	Assistant Counselors (6 male/6 female)	12	Same as above. Level of experience and proficiency in counseling doesn't have to be as high.

Auxiliary Staff (10) ➤ Responsible to the Manager ➤ Specialize in physical needs (food, medicine, first aid, sanitation) of all camp participants	Admin. Asst./Asst. Manager	1	Assist manager on trips to town and assist with office tasks. Computer ability helps.
	Canteen/Laundry	1	Wash soiled linens in the mornings and serve snacks during the afternoon rotation.
	Kitchen Staff		
	➤ Head Cook	1	Experience with quantity cooking. Responsible for all meal related details except menu planning and purchasing. This includes food and dining hall preparation and clean-up, as well as tending to dishes.
	➤ Assistant Cook	1	Assist the cook.
	➤ Dishwasher/Dining Room	3	Assist with food prep as needed. Set the dining hall before each meal and clean afterwards.
	Nurse (MO cert req'd)	1	Track and distribute medication. Provide first aid and advise the camp team regarding medical attention for all camp participants.
	Janitor	1	Maintain clean "public" areas on the campground. Stock all bathrooms. Oversee work of Asst. Janitor?
Asst. Janitor/Asst. Canteen	1	Assist the janitor except during the afternoon rotation, during which they assist in the canteen.	
Activity Staff (17) ➤ Responsible to the Recreation Director ➤ Specialize in campers' learning, education, and guidance while engaged in specific activities.	Recreation Staff (at least 4 of the 6 must be lifeguard certified)	6	Oversee recreational activities such as canoeing, swimming, archery, group games/sports, free play time, trust course, fishing, hiking, camping, etc. Work with counselors to assist campers. Usually assigned to lifeguard one or two hours per day.
	Craft Staff		
	➤ Craft Director	1	Oversee and instruct craft assistants as they work with counselors to assist campers in the afternoon. Prepare materials for upcoming crafts.
	➤ Craft Assistants	4	Work with counselors to assist children succeed with pre-planned crafts in the afternoon. Assist the craft director in craft preparation.
	Chapel Staff		
	➤ Teacher	1	Facilitate chapel teaching times (i.e. scripture memory activity, object lessons, scripture lesson, etc.) Lessons are themed with nightly skits, devotions, and crafts and are provided ahead of time, but the teacher must prepare well in advance. Also responsible for preparing and distributing materials for cabin devotions as needed.
➤ Music/Skit	5	Facilitate group participation in chapel. Provide "kid-oriented" music time with our "traditional camp songs" two to four times per day. Prepare skit before camp and present a nightly "episode."

Bus Monitors ➤ Responsible to supervise campers on trips to and from camp. ➤ Ability to work with children and develop repair.	24	Training will be provided the morning before the trip to/from camp. Volunteer Application must be completed and permission to do a background check.
Luggage Helpers	4	Help unload luggage and help with organization of parents. Time commitment about one hour.
Camp clean up crews	6-8	Assist with cleaning camp after each week and at the end of the season. This includes doing large amounts of laundry.
